The safety and security of our little angles and Academy team are a top priority for Little Angels Learning Academy. To become even safer in times of emergency and natural disasters, we are working cooperatively with the Greene County Health Department in preparing classroom emergency kits. This will also help us to ultimately be recognized and receive the designation as a "Child Safe" facility, and be a model for other facilities in keeping young children safe.

As part of this process, we are putting together Classroom Emergency Kits to be used in case of emergencies and natural disasters, etc. We need your cooperation in providing the following items for your child's kit:

Infants:

Extra change of clothes, including socks

1 small bottle

4 diapers

Package of wipes

1 pacifier/binkie

1 receiving blanket

Any extra medicine

Other items as deemed necessary

Toddlers:

Extra change of clothes, including

1 small bottle/sippy cup

4 diapers

Package of wipes

1 pacifier/binkie

1 receiving blanket

Any extra medicine

1 comfort item

Other items as deemed necessary

Preschoolers:

Extra change of clothes, including socks and underwear

4 pullups (if necessary)

1 comfort item

1 small blanket

Small game or book activity

Any extra medicine

Other items as deemed necessary

Please provide these items in a Ziplock gallon-sized plastic bag. Please mark ALL items with your child's name.

Turn the bag into you little angel's teacher.

We will provide other items in the classroom kit such as; first aid kits, food, water, etc. for all children to use during the time until emergency personal can reach us.

Also remember that if necessary, our population will evacuate to the Battlefield First Baptist Church in the case that our facility is destroyed, etc.

NOTICE

It is VERY important that we stay in compliance with the Dept of Health Guidelines. Please be aware that:

ALL children MUST have a cot sheet.

Children 2 years of age and older MUST have a small blanket along with a cot sheet.

These items are sent home for laundering each week.

\$30.00 will be placed on your child's tuition account for a **new** sheet and blanket. This will be especially occur when parents habitually do not bring a sheet or blanket. If we have to provide more than 2 sets, we will keep one at LALA, and charge your account for laundering and maintaining these items at a cost of \$5.00 per week for washing and drying costs.

We will gladly accept donations of extra cot sheets and blankets, because we understand that every once in a while we forget things, too – so we can provide a sheet and blanket whenever possible. But these items are few and far between and there have been LOTS of parents forgetting to bring cot sheets and blankets on a regular basis.
